

Directions to Richmond

From the north: Take I-43 south to Route 12. Go south on Route 12 to Richmond's fire station.

From the south: Take I-94 to IL Route 173. Go west on Route 173 to IL Route 12. Go south on Route 12 to Richmond's fire station. Rt. 12 (Rand Rd) also leads to Richmond from Chicago and the NW suburbs.

- Registration is from 7:00 AM to 11:00 AM
- 62 and 50 mile riders please start by 10:00 am.
- Post Ride Meal starts at 11:00 AM
- Routes of between 20 and 62 miles (100 kilometers) will be available. Ride the distance you want to ride.
- The 20 and 25 mile routes have one rest stop.
- The 36 mile route has two rest stops.
- The 50 and 62 mile routes have three rest stops.
- If you like hills, the metric century will have over 3000 feet of climbing!
- All routes start and end at Richmond FD.
- Do multiple routes to increase your miles!

We hope you will come out to Richmond Illinois for a fall day ride. Choose from routes of 20 to 62 miles.* The terrain is flat to gently rolling with an occasional hill. (The 62 mile route has some big hills!) Rest stops will be spaced approximately every 15 miles. The 62 mile route has longer legs. If you don't want to ride on the road, the Prairie Trail (crushed stone screenings) goes right by the station. Bring the kids for a bicycle ride and to check out the Fire Trucks. Children 5 and under are free.

All routes will have route maps and cue sheets, rest stops with food and water. SAG service will be provided.

Online registration is available until October 7th @9:59 PST.
Early registration online is heavily discounted.

T-shirts are available for \$15 if ordered before October 2nd. A limited number will be available on the day of the event for \$20.

Make sure you bring your camera for photo opportunities.

Official routes are entirely on roads. There is also easy access to the Prairie Trail which is crushed limestone screenings. While not part of the official routes, this trail offers alternative off road riding.

** Miles are approximate. Miles may vary slightly due to route requirements. The route is mainly country roads.*
